

Governor signs seat belt legislation

seat belt law will be strengthened to encourage teenagers to buckle up under a bill signed Wednesday by Gov. Kathleen Sebelius. The new law, which goes into ef-

fect July 1, requires anyone in the front seat to wear a seat belt or face a \$30 fine. Starting Jan. 1, the failure of any-

one between 14 and 18 years old to wear a seat beat will bring a \$60 fine. Currently such fines are \$10. "There's no question that wear-

ing a seat belt could save your life, and we want drivers to get in the habit of buckling up every time they get in the car," Sebelius said in a statement.

Other provisions of the bill include doubling the fine for speeding in a school zone on state highways and creating emergency
