## Regents' appointments expected

TOPEKA (AP) — With six of nine members' terms already expired or set to expire this month, Gov. Kathleen Sebelius has an opportunity to remake the board that oversees the state's higher education system.

"I would say in the next month or so, we'd have the six appointments," Sebelius spokeswoman Nicole Corcoran said Monday. But the governor's decision to wait a full year to fill three positions on the Board of Regents was questioned by one former member. Former Senate President Dick Bond's term on the board expired in June 2006, but he served another nine months, resigning in March to recover from back surgery.

The regents oversee state universities and supervise community colleges and vocational-technical colleges.

The state spends \$2.1 billion annually on higher education, and state universities have more than 17,000 employees, or 41 percent of those who work for state government.

"There will be a new majority in July without experience, and historically the board has tried to bring people along in leadership," Bond, a former Senate president, told the Lawrence Journal-World.

He added: "It's helpful to be able to develop and train for leadership and continuity, and that's the problem this presents when there are not

timely appointments."

Besides Bond, of Overland Park, the four-year terms of Donna Shank, of Liberal, and James Grier III, of Wichita, expired last year, though Grier and Shank have remained on the board.

Terms expire this month for Janice DeBauge, of Emporia; Frank Gaines, of Manhattan; and board Chairman Nelson Galle, of Manhattan. Asked why she hadn't reappointed them or filled their positions, Sebelius said, "I really wanted to wait through the election."

"We want to be responsive to legislative requests and responsive to the needs of the state. There is a push-pull that is always going to be there," Sebelius said.
