## **Enrollment increases** slightly at universities

TOPEKA (AP)—Enrollment at the six schools. state universities increased only slightly this fall, and most of the jump came at Fort Hays State University, which has the lowest tuition rate of the six schools.

The Kansas Board of Regents released figures Thursday showing 88,817, an increase of 547, or 0.6 percent, from fall 2004.

Of the 547 students, 519 were at Fort Hays, which had 9,019 students and posted the biggest percentage increase at 6.1 percent. Its in-state undergraduate tuition was \$1,527 for the fall semester.

On-campus students numbered 4,534, a drop of 189 from last fall.

One reason for the overall increase was the number of distancelearning students.

Enrollment in the Virtual College which totaled 10,948 students for by 657 to 21,408.

Leading the state in enrollment was the University of Kansas with 29,624, which includes 2,690 students at its medical center in Kansas City, Kan., for a 0.1 percent in-

crease over last year. That university had the highest the enrollment at all schools was tuition rate, \$2,706 for in-state undergraduates.

The second-highest enrollment was at Kansas State University with 23,182 students, an increase of 0.1

The only school to lose enrollment was Wichita State with 14,076, a 1.6 percent drop.

Emporia State had 6,288 students for a 1.5 percent increase, and Pittsburg State's enrollment increased 1.4 percent to 6,628.




