Economists disagree on the effectiveness of this measure, but before you go thanking your Congressional leaders for the "free money" make sure you remember where that money comes from and make sure you save enough of it to pay your bills (and taxes) again next year, or even better, invest! Just because consumer spending is more than two-thirds of economic activity in the United States, that doesn't mean that extra spending is the best choice for you and your

So even before the check arrives, take a moment and let reality set in. Sit down with your budget, check book and a calculator to decide what should be done with the money. Develop your own stimulus package.

# Sherman County revises burn permit

Commissioner Chuck Thomas said it should be good for the calendar year. Duell agreed that made sense. He asked about adding the term "authorized tenant" to the wording to make it apply to both a landowner and tenant. Rasure said that would be a good change.
