Wichita boy named finalist

WICHITA (AP) — He could win \$10,000, but Michael Flores isn't too concerned about that. What he really wants — what would be really, truly, totally awesome — is his name on the bottom of a Hot Wheels car.

"That," says the 8-year-old, "would be cool."

Michael, an Andover third-grader, is one of 10 finalists in a national Hot Wheels contest: the "Trick Tracks Video Challenge."

The contest challenged youngsters to build "the ultimate tricked-out track" and make a video showing how it works.

Earlier this month, 10 top designs, including Michael's, were posted on the Hot Wheels Web site.

Visitors can vote for their favorite track; the winner will

get \$10,000, a 2009 model Hot Wheels car named after him, and 200 of those cars.

Other finalists' videos, meanwhile, look stunning, even professional, with blaring music, snappy editing and special effects.

"I had no idea what I was doing," Tracey Flores said. "I've never uploaded a video in my life. We just did our best."

Now that Michael's a finalist, Tracey and her husband, Jorge, are focused on marketing. They've sent e-mails to friends and family members, asking them to vote for Michael's video once a day through the contest's deadline, April 7.

For being a finalist, Michael won a \$500 American Express Gift Card. At 97 cents apiece, that's a lot of Hot Wheels cars.
