statistics," American Society of these tragedies." Safety Engineers President Michael W. Thompson, said Monday during a meeting in Washington, D.C., to recognize North American Occupational Safety and Health Week.

Thompson cited recent accidents to substantiate his point.

"Just look at the recent crane accident fatalities – last week a man was crushed to death in Annapolis while working on a crane," he

"A few weeks ago people died in New York City on a Saturday when a crane tumbled - changing lives and a neighborhood forever. Another sad part of that story is that we communicated key crane safety information to the public and our members recently and helped the media, including one reporter in Florida.

Her crane incident story appeared with the headline 'It could happen here' You know what? It did," he said.

A day after the story appeared a crane toppled in Miami killing more workers - including a member of the American Society of Safety Engineers, he said.

"That member's family is now setting up a scholarship in his name through the ASSE Foundation - one way they are working to face the pain of losing a father, a husband — these are not just statistics, these are people we are losing."

"They are our family, our friends, our co-workers – not just a number. We need to keep working to increase the dialogue worldwide on the importance of making

Yet, people are still dying from on-the-job injuries, he said. The number was close to 6,000 people in 2006 – so everyone needs to look to this safety and health week as an opportunity for all to start or continue the dialogue on the need for more companies, employers and employees to focus on being safe at work," Thompson said.

In the U.S. alone, the National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health reported that occupational injuries and illness expenditures total nearly \$171 billion a year and injury and illness costs can approach up to 5 percent of an organization's total costs.

Establishing and sustaining effective safety and health systems can reduce costs by 20 to 40 percent, the report noted.

Safety's positive return on investment is gaining greater attention too, Thompson said.

"It's no secret that workplace fatality rates and injuries continue to go down, due in part to the work of safety and health professionals.

Notice of Public Hearing Concerning Electric Rate Increase Request

Midwest Energy has filed an application with the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) requesting an annual electric service rate increase of \$10.0 million, or an overall increase of approximately 10.47 percent.

The rate request does not involve the wholesale cost of electricity, which is the cost Midwest Energy pays to other utilities for bulk supplies, or the upstream transmission costs incurred to deliver those bulk supplies to the Midwest Energy system. Wholesale and upstream transmission costs are passed through without

In its application, Midwest Energy said the primary reasons for the request include: (1) General inflation of construction and operating costs in the 5 ½ years since the prior request. (2) Construction of the Goodman Energy Center which will be used in part to replace expiring power supply contracts, (3) Costs of replacements and upgrades to an aging transmission and distribution system, and (4) Extraordinary restoration costs resulting from extreme storm damage in 2005-2007. Midwest Energy proposes to implement a formula transmission rate that would result in annual changes to electric transmission rates as allowed by Kansas statute. Midwest Energy also is requesting permission to split its M System General Service Large rate class into two rate classes, resulting in creation of a General Service Medium class.
