





## Famous Hand

Partscore contracts are not usually as dramatic as games or slams, but they provide at least as many opportunities for skillful play. Here is an exceptionally well-defended hand played in an intercity match many years ago between Los Angeles and New

The L.A. South opened one heart, West (Howard Schenken) doubled, and East (George Rapee) responded one spade. Rapee's hand was much stronger than his spade response suggested, but he judged it not quite good enough for a jump-response.

After South bid two clubs, West and North passed. Rapee now felt he had to do something to show his values, so he doubled, and everyone passed. Schenken decided to lead a trump in order to protect any heart strength his partner might have. After playing the ace and viewing dummy, he continued with the eight of clubs, on which dummy played low, and so did Rapee!

Had Rapee won the eight and returned a trump, South would have made the contract. Dummy's nine would have provided an entry for a successful heart finesse, and declarer would have lost only one spade, one heart, one diamond and two clubs.

As it was, South won the club eight with the ten and led the king of spades. Schenken very properly ducked, but won the next spade with the ace and returned a low diamond. Rapee won with the king, cashed the trump king and returned a diamond. Declarer ruffed and played the A-3 of hearts. Rapee took the jack and returned his last diamond.

Declarer ruffed and played another heart. Rapee won with the king -- the sixth trick for the defense -- but had to concede the last two tricks to dummy's Q-J of spades.

East-West didn't score much -- 100 points -- but they earned every point they got. At the other table, where the defense was less inspired, South made three clubs.
