grass land.

Broken down to a monthly amount, the taxpayer would pay an extra \$1.79 on 160 acres dry crop land; \$2.98 for 160 acres irrigated land; and \$.32 on 160 acres grass land.

"With these new figures, I feel like the increase in taxes would be doable," Bruce Feikert, board member, said.

The 90 million people watching the Super Bowl, many of them children, heard Justin Timberlake sing, "Gonna have you naked by the end of this song," as he reached for Jackson's bustier.

The court found that the FCC deviated from its nearly 30-year practice of fining indecent broadcast programming only when it was so "pervasive as to amount to 'shock treatment' for the audi-

The FCC did not immediately respond to a request for comment.

> In challenging the fine, CBS said that "fleeting, isolated or unintended" images should not automatically be considered indecent.

But the FCC said Jackson and Timberlake were employees of CBS and that the network should have to pay for their "willful" actions, given its lack of oversight.

The \$550,000 fine represents the maximum \$27,500 levied against each of the network's 20 owned-and-operated stations.

Shortly after the 2004 Super Bowl, the FCC changed its policy on fleeting indecency following an NBC broadcast of the Golden Globes awards show on which U2 lead singer Bono uttered an unscripted expletive. The FCC said at the time that the "F-word" in any context "inherently has a sexual connotation" and can trig-

NBC challenged the decision, but that case has yet to be resolved.

In June 2007, a federal appeals court in New York invalidated the government's policy on fleeting profanities uttered over the airwaves in a case involving remarks by Cher and Nicole Richie on awards shows carried on Fox stations. The Supreme Court will hear the case this fall.

Recovery slow in year for town

COFFEYVILLE (AP) - A year after a refinery oil spill into floodwaters blanketed a third of the southeast Kansas town of Coffeyville, little remains in the area that was damaged.

The oil-drenched houses are gone, and only a few have been rebuilt. About 1,000 displaced homeowners have scattered across surrounding towns. And nearly half of the 70 affected businesses have yet to come back.

"These funds provide an opportunity for producers hit by flooding to repair and/or replace the damaged practices and keep their investment and conservation practices working.

Any structural or vegetative conservation practice originally installed with NRCS financial assistance and/or technical assistance and still functioning at the time of the flooding would be eligible. Practices are not eligible

if the damage was due to lack of maintenance or caused by a nonflood related event.

"There are a lot of practices out there that would be eligible; for example, washed out terraces and grass seedings, damaged ponds, and streambank stabilization systems that failed," said Troy J. Munsch, Assistant State Conservationist for Programs in Kansas.
