



# Former agent **Markets** writes novel

KANSAS CITY, Mo. (AP) A retired FBI agent has written a book about the organized crime in Kansas City he was

once assigned to pursue. William Ouseley's new book, "Open City: True Story of the KC Crime Family" traces the birth and spread of organized

crime in Kansas City. Ouseley, now 72, retired from the FBI in 1985 as supervisor of the Kansas City Field Division of the Organized Crime Squad.

"After 21 years of working on the street, there were a lot of people encouraging me to tell the stories," he said.

"The history took me over, though. I found it was a book in itself.

"That's why I only got from 1900 to 1953.

The Lenexa resident writes about the roots of crime societies in Southern Italy and Sicily, which became known as Black Hand once they arrived in the Midwest.

"I don't think people understand the impact organized crime has had on the underpinnings of our society: infiltration of business, infiltration of the labor unions, infiltration of politics and government."
