Recipe for chicken tortilla soup shared

Dear Heloise: We vacationed in Texas recently and had a lovely time. We ate at several Mexican restaurants and enjoyed the tortilla soup. Now that we are home, I would like to make some. Do you have a recipe you could share? Thanks so much!

 Vivian in New York Well, my editorial director (originally a Texan but now a New Yorker), Merry Clark, shared a fabulous recipe for chicken tortilla soup that I would be happy to pass along. To make it, you will need:

- 12 corn tortillas
- 1/2 cup olive oil
- 2 onions, chopped
- 1/2 cup tomato puree
- 4 quarts rich chicken stock
- 2 cups cooked chicken, diced

• 2 tablespoons fresh cilantro • Dash of cayenne pepper and Parmesan cheese

Cut tortillas into strips and fry in oil until crisp (just like tortilla chips). Drain and set aside. Saute onions in olive oil and add tomato puree and stock, then the chicken and cilantro. Cook over medium heat for about an hour. Top each serving with a sprinkle of cayenne and Parmesan cheese, and the tortilla strips. Do you need to thicken up a soup? Add instant mashed potatoes, a little at a time. And if you don't tell, no one will even know. - Heloise

FYI: Some people like to add the tortilla strips the last 10-15 minutes of cooking so they are soft when it's time to serve. Try it both ways.

Speaking of soup, here's a question for you: Is it OK to eat canned soup right from the can? A leading soup manufacturer told us yes, you can. The soups are already cooked, so they are safe to eat cold, right from the can. -Heloise
