Manufacturer gets tentative OK for Nebraska incentives

GRAND ISLAND, Neb. (AP) — Economic development officials say a foreign manufacturer is considering investing \$70 million in either Grand Island or a Kansas location to build its first U.S. plant.

Marlan Ferguson with the Grand Island Area Economic Development Corp. said a local committee recommended giving the unnamed manufacturer \$600,000 in incentives.

The Grand Island City Council will consider those incentives and up to \$5.5 million in tax-increment financing next Tuesday. The name of the company developing the plant is expected to be announced before the meeting.

Ferguson has offered only vague hints about the company's identity.

He said the 320,000-square-foot building would have 34-foot-high

side walls because the plant would produce a very large product.

Ferguson also said 15 rail cars would be brought into the plant every week and seven rail cars would go out every week.

The rest of the inbound and outbound traffic would be by truck.

The rail service available may determine where the plant is built.

"They're still finalizing a couple things in both locations — primarily the rail service," Ferguson said.

The tax-increment financing Grand Island is offering would pay for extending plumbing lines, buying 165 acres, paving the road leading to the site and upgrading rail lines.

In return for the \$600,000 incentives, the company promised to hire 300 people by 2012 and maintain the jobs at least through 2014.

Ferguson said the plant would employ welders, machinists, engineers, administrators and a painting unit.

If the jobs aren't maintained, the company must repay the \$600,000 incentive funds at 8 percent interest, the agreement stated.

Ferguson said the company plans to start building the plant this fall.

The terms of the incentive agreement would require the company to invest \$70 million in the plant by 2010.

Nebraska Tax Commissioner Doug Ewald said Wednesday that the incentive money Grand Island is offering comes from local sales tax revenue, and state officials are not involved in those decisions. Ewald said he was not aware of any recent applications for state incentives for any projects in Grand Island.

'Net Wrap' is new product

Guess who's coming to dinner? That was the name of a movie years ago. It might also be a description of how one modern international business relationship came into being. That relationship led to a remarkable growing business based on a product called net wrap.

Last week we learned about David Liefer and his company which sells synthetic fibers for use in agricultural and construction applications. A key supplier of those products is located in Junction City, Kansas and is named UPU Industries.

Philip Orr is the managing director of UPU Industries. He explains that UPU Industries is the latest part of a family business. Philip is an Irishman. Years ago, his father Steve started working in the Belfast Rope Works making rope and twine products at age 14.

Steve worked his way up through the company to become managing director. In 1976, he started his own company to represent European mills trading in twine and related products. Philip joined the company and became managing director in 1996. By that time the company had opened its own plant to manufacture such products in Northern Ireland.

In 1996, Philip's company had a booth at an exposition called the Royal Smithfield Show in London. A company representative from Spain stopped by their booth and asked if he could join Philip's party for dinner — and then another did the same — and by the way, he said, was it okay if he brought a couple of customers from America? Philip politely consented.

It was a case of "Guess who's coming to dinner?" The two American customers were David

Liefer and his father who happened to be visiting the exposition from the U.S. At dinner, the Lieferers talked about their baling twine business back in Kansas.

This fortuitous connection was the beginning of a business relationship. Philip's manufacturing company, now known as UPU Industries, became a supplier for the Liefer's business. UPU Industries had become a maker of net wrap.

Net wrap is like a super-industrial strength version of Saran Wrap™. It is a woven, high density polyethylene plastic which is wrapped around large round hay bales to preserve their quality and protect them from water damage.

Net wrap provides significant fuel and labor benefits for hay producers. It is an estimated ten times faster than using baler twine, sheds moisture, and enables bales to be transported with minimum leaf loss.

UPU Industries became the first European company to build a net wrap production plant in the U.S. After looking at states and communities all over the Midwest, Philip and his company decided to build the plant in Junction City, Kansas.

Philip says, "I appreciated the get-up-and-go approach of the people in Junction City." After the decision was made, he called David Liefer and said, "David, guess what - we're going to be neighbors."

The plant represents a \$15 million investment and was built in only six months. UPU Industries

is already preparing for another phase of expansion. The plant does the extrusion of the plastics and the automated knitting of the net wrap. It is used for hay, as pallet wrap for fruit shipments, and car wrap for transporting autos. For haying, the product's brand name is Farmer's Full Coverage Netwrap.

Today, UPU Industries is the largest netwrap producer in the United States.

The company provides employment for 60 people in Junction City and the region around it, including those who come from such rural towns as Chapman, Herington, White City, Riley, and Milford — population 483 people. Now, that's rural.

How exciting to find an international business relationship which has created this growing enterprise.

Guess who's coming to dinner. In this case, it was a couple of Kansans who came to dinner, and that would lead to a business connection around the industry of net wrap.

Then this northern Ireland company would go on to build a multimillion dollar facility to produce its products in Kansas. We commend Philip Orr and the people of UPU Industries for making a difference with their transatlantic business relationship. For this remarkable story, that's a wrap.

Pinnacle pulls plug on casino proposal

TOPEKA (AP) — Pinnacle Entertainment Inc. dropped out of the running to manage a state-run casino in Wyandotte County, becoming the fourth company to bow out of the competition to run one of the four Kansas facilities.

The decision was presented late Monday afternoon to the Kansas Lottery, which owns the gambling.

Pinnacle's letter came four days before the Lottery Gaming Facility Review Board picks who should manage one casino each in Wyandotte and Ford counties.

The brief letter gave no reason

for Pinnacle withdrawing, saying only it was exercising its right under the management contract it signed in May with the Lottery. It also asked for the return of a \$25 million privilege fee all applicants paid when they signed a contract.

In a statement Tuesday, Pinnacle, which generated revenues of \$924 million last year, indicated the economy was a factor. It owns and operates six casinos in Indiana, Louisiana, Missouri and Nevada, plus several small casinos in Argentina.

"In view of the current turmoil in the financial markets, the com-

pany has decided to focus its resources on its existing projects and development opportunities in Louisiana, Missouri and other jurisdictions," it said.

In Wyandotte County, Pinnacle had proposed a \$624 million facility with 2,300 slot machines, 60 table games and a 500-room hotel.

"We are sorry to see it. They are a very quality applicant, as are the others," said Ed Van Petten, Lottery executive director, adding the privilege fee will be returned.

When the review board meets Friday, it will have three options left for Wyandotte County, all near the Kansas Speedway. The remaining applicants are Legends Sun, Golden Gaming Inc. and Kansas Entertainment, which includes the Speedway and Cordish Co.

The area — near the junction of Interstates 70 and 435 in Kansas City — has attracted substantial retail development in recent years.

The review board also will decide Friday whether Butler National Service Corp. or Dodge City Resort or Gaming will get the Ford County contract.

Last month, it picked Harrah's Entertainment Inc., for Sumner County and Penn National Gaming Inc., for Cherokee County.
