Trojans see mixed results at shootout

The Colby Community College Volleyball team finished 2-5 at the Wyo-Braska Shootout Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

The tournament was hosted by Western Nebraska Community College in Scottsbluff, Neb. and Eastern Wyoming in Torrington, Wyo., and matches were played at both places.

The Lady Trojans picked up wins over Laramie, Wyo., and North Platte, Neb. North Platte was the 20th ranked volleyball team in Division II going into the tournament.

Colby was defeated by Sheridan Community College, Western Nebraska, Northwest Wyoming, Casper and Eastern Wyoming.

Lady Trojans Coach Valerie Armstrong said she was pleased with the win over North Platte. The Lady Trojans outlasted North Platte 23-25, 23-25, 25-23, 25-19, and 15-10. Freshman Julianna Motta Da Silva had 27 kills and 28 digs in the match. Freshman Cassie Smatana had 24 digs and 3 service aces.

Perhaps the most painful loss the Lady Trojans sustained at the shootout was when Casper defeat-

ed them 26-24 in the second game of the match. They led by six late in the game before the T-Birds rallied. Casper would go on to defeat Colby in the third game 25-17.

Sophomore Rexanne Schilowsky had 11 kills and 2 service aces in the match and sophomore Priscila Sena had 33 set assists.

Armstrong said a switch she made in the lineup, which moved sophomore Megan Dennis to a hitter position and freshman Cassie Smatana to Libero, improved the teams play at the tournament. Armstrong said this change will continue if the team keeps playing better with the current rotation.

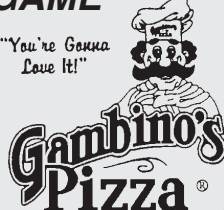
