### Fossett searchers see plane

MAMMOTH LAKES, Calif. (AP) - Searchers found the wreckage of Steve Fossett's plane in California's rugged Sierra Nevada just over a year after the millionaire adventurer vanished on a solo flight, and the craft appears to have hit the mountainside headon, authorities said today.

Crews conducting an aerial search late Wednesday spotted what turned out to be the wreckage in the Inyo National Forest near the town of Mammoth Lakes, Sheriff John Anderson said. They confirmed around 11 p.m. that the tail number found matched Fossett's single-engine Bellanca plane, he said.

Anderson said no human remains were found in the wreck-

"It's quite often if you don't find remains within a few days, because of animals, you'll find nothing at all," Anderson said.

Teams led by the sheriff's department would continue the search for remains Thursday, while the National today Safety Board was en route to probe the cause of the crash, he said.

Most of the plane's fuselage disintegrated on impact.

#### Governor wants to reopen tracks

TOPEKA (AP) - Gov. Kathleen Sebelius said Wednesday the state should search for new operators for closed dog and horse tracks before giving up some of its potential slot machine revenues to the current owners.

Sebelius reacted cautiously to a proposal to reduce the state's take - now 40 percent - in hopes of getting the owners of The Woodlands in Kansas City, Kan., and Camptown Greyhound Park near Pittsburg to reopen.

A 2007 law allowing slot machines at the two parks was designed to boost their business while providing revenues to the state. But the owners said turning over 40 percent of their slots revenue to the state would make the business unprofitable.

"What we don't know is if that's the opinion of just these two individuals who own the tracks, or if there are others out there," Sebelius said at a brief news conference. "I'm told that there may well be others who say, 'Give me




