Gas prices down again

WICHITA (AP) — In the shadow of the nation's economic meltdown, there is at least one bit of good news for Kansans: Gasoline prices are dropping to levels that haven't been seen in about a year and are well below the national average.

The AAA Fuel Gauge report shows Kansas' average price of a gallon of regular unleaded was \$2.81 today, down 73 cents from just a month ago.

A year ago, the statewide average was \$2.67 per gallon, and Wichita and some other Kansas locales are at or approaching that level now.

Kansas City, Kansas, and Lawrence have the highest average

prices in Kansas cities at \$2.84 per gallon. In the Topeka area, pump prices are slightly less than

\$2.73 per gallon. AAA says today's national average price was \$3.20, down 53 cents from a month ago. A year ago the nation's average was \$2.76.

Experts say pump prices are the result of declining crude oil and wholesale gas costs.
