

The increase, which will start in seas," said Sung Won Sohn, an January, was announced Thursday economics professor at the Smith by the Social Security Administration. It will mean an additional \$63 per month for the average retiree.

The increase is the largest since a 7.4 percent jump in 1982 and is more than double the 2.3 percent rise that retirees got in their taken a hit because of what is hapmonthly checks starting in January of this year.

The typical retiree's monthly check will go from \$1,090 currently to \$1,153.

But the fatter Social Security check may still seem puny to millions of retirees battered this year by huge increases in energy and food costs who have also watched helplessly as their retirement savings have been assaulted by the biggest upheavals on Wall Street in seven decades.
