Helen Kogl Kleidosty, 91, mother of Mariana (Jerry) Thomas of Colby, died Saturday, Oct. 18, 2008, at the Rawlins County Health Center in Atwood.

She was born Nov 8, 1916, in Pocasset, Okla., the daughter of Louis and Katherine (Lippold) Ketterl. When she was 4, her parents, her sister Margaret, and brothers, Lester, Clarence and Lavern, moved to a farm northeast of Herndon. She attended Green Valley School and St. Mary's High School in Herndon, then taught in rural schools after graduation.

She married Math Kogl on Sept.

12, 1940. They lived on the family farm until 1973, when they moved to Atwood. Her husband died Aug. 23, 1983. She married Matt Kleidosty in 1991 in Glendale, Calif. He died Oct. 23, 1992. She moved to the Good Samaritan Home in Atwood in February 2007.

She was also preceded in death by her parents, a sister, seven sisters-in-law, three brothers, eight brothers-in-law and a son-in-law.
