Senior Lindsey Wilson and sophomore Caitlyn Wark became the first players to win a state tennis championship for Colby High School since a singles player won the title in 1981.

"It was a moment of glory for them," Coach Jennifer Rall said. "They worked so hard and really proved they were deserving of the state champion title. I was very proud of them."


