More details of the mostly private visit by Obama and his wife, Michelle, emerged today, just hours before they were arrive for a visit and tour of the Executive Mansion. The visit is certain to give the president-elect his first feel for the place where momentous decisions will soon fall to

Bush invited Obama for the private talk, a rite of passage between presidents and successors that extends back for decades.

The moment is sure to be steeped in history, part of a symbolic changing of the guard to Democratic leadership and the country's first black president. But it will be substantive as well, as Bush and Obama are expected to review the nation's enormous economic downturn and the war in Iraq.

Obama and Bush will be the only ones in the Oval Office when they meet.




