She said another man eventually came out of the house and said that he would shoot the dog if he ever saw it on his property again.

"It's a sad, sad situation," Tubbs said. "I have lived here for 22 years, and never had any problems until they threatened to kill my animals."

She and her husband have two dogs, and the dogs are never let out unless one of them is watching them.

Reached by telephone, Zimmerman wouldn't say why he shot the dog.

Sheriff Baughn said today that the department had sent the report to the county attorney's office recommending that the shooter be charged with cruelty to animals.
