ORDINANCE NO. 1454

ORDINANCE **CHAPTER XIV, ARTICLE 2, SECTION** 14-208, PARAGRAPH (C), OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS, PERTAINING TO TRUCK PARKING IN RESIDENTIAL ZONES IN THE CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS:

Chapter XIV, Article 2, Local Traffic Regulations, Section 14-208, paragraph (c) is hereby amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. LOCAL TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

14-208. TRUCK PARKING.

(c) No truck, truck trailer, tractor trailer, as defined in Subsection (d) of this section, machinery, equipment or mobile home shall be parked for more than two hours upon any lot, improved or unimproved, within the single family, duplex and multiple family zoned districts (R-1; R-2; R-3) or the mobile home community zoned district (R-2MH) as defined and designated by the zoning ordinance of the City of Colby. Thomas County. Kansas: provided, however, that nothing herein shall prohibit the loading or unloading of cargo to or from the truck, truck trailer, tractor trailer, or trailer.

Section 14-208, paragraph (c) of the Code of the City of Colby as previously adopted by Ordinance No. 1452 is hereby

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law
