The couple plans to live in Gardner after the wedding.

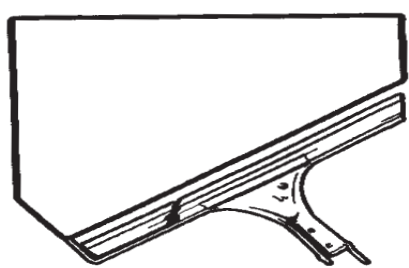
