

Writers take note

Kansas writers are encouraged to enter the 20th annual Kansas Voices writing contest sponsored by the Winfield Arts and Humanities Council.

Short stories, prose or poetry are all accepted; all must be unpublished and accompanied by an entry form and a \$3 fee for each submission.

Writers may enter either youth or adult divisions in poetry or prose. The youth division is for those enrolled in high school or younger than 18. Writers must live in Kansas and entries must be postmarked by March 15.

No particular subject matter is required, and all entries will be

judged by professionals, entirely on literary merit.

Winners will be invited to read their work at a dinner at the council headquarters at 6 p.m. Saturday, May 2, as a part of the Kanza Days celebration.
