

Garden season is coming fast

I appreciate the opportunity given me by Steve Haynes, owner of Nor'West Newspapers, to jot down a few ideas about the gardening procedure that might be of interest to you each week.

When I was discussing this idea with Tom Betz, and as we began working out the details of the columns, we decided that about 500 words per week should be sufficient for me to get my thoughts across to you. I also suggested that it might be a good idea to be sure my column wasn't any longer than Cynthia Haynes' column, which I read and enjoy each week.

I also promised not to write about the cats that roam the rooms of our house as long as Cynthia didn't spend too much time writing about gardening.

I visited by telephone last week with old friend Tom Dreiling at The Norton Telegram,* (Emphasis here on the old*). Tom and I go waaaay back to our days in Hays and here in Goodland. I'm fortunate to have friends and assorted golfing acquaintances in most of the other areas where these papers reach.

Whether we realize it or not, the beginning of a new garden season is not all that far away, and for



most of us who love to dig in the dirt, it's not a bit too soon. After all, we've spent most of the winter studying those seed catalogs and watching basketball games and we need to climb down off the couch and out into the fresh air and get to work.

The average last frost date in most of northwest Kansas is about May 5, which of course is just an average. It can occur either a couple of weeks before or after that date. The early season coolweather vegetable crops such as lettuce, onions, radishes and peas should be in the ground by April 10 to 15, if not earlier, so we definitely need to buy our seed now and do what we can to locate the shovel, the rake and the hoe in preparation for a new season of fun and good eating.

Those of us grow our own tomato, pepper, cabbage and broccoli plants know there will be work to do before we can even think about planting outside. I'll

write about that process when the time comes.

There are a number of readers who know I have a handy-dandy garden book out on the market. I published it last summer and it covers just about all facets of vegetable gardening. The book is entitled "The Gardeners Common Sense Guide to Vegetable Gardening in the Midwest." It has over 200 pages of of tips and ideas about more than two dozen vegetables, plus chapters on soil, seed selection, proper watering procedures, and even some important (and some unimportant) recipes.

People who garden or are thinking of gardening, seem to enjoy it. The \$15 price tag is probably too high, but older plain-dirt gardeners on a fixed income also need to try to make a living too. The book is available within easy driving distance from where you live. And I thank you for buying it.


