Monday deadline on water

The new Agricultural Water Enhancement Program allows the U.S. Natural Resources Conservation Service to enter into partnership agreements to conserve ground and surface water or improve water quality.

Proposals should be submitted to the national headquarters and state conservationist by Monday.

Eligible groups include states, local government, agricultural or silvicultural associations or producer groups such as irrigation associations, agricultural land trusts or other nongovernment organizations that have experience working with farmers and ranchers.

The program was authorized under the Environmental Quality Incentives Program in the 2008 Farm Bill. All federal money will be paid to producers; none may be used for administrative expenses. Higher priority may go to proposals located in several regions, including the Ogallala Aquifer.

Disaster loan deadline nears

The deadline for farmers and ranchers to file for Farm Service Agency emergency disaster loans in Gove, Logan and Thomas counties is Monday, March 9.

Dwight Jurey, farm loan manager for the U.S. Department of Agriculture agency in Oakley, said operators who need credit as a result of storms, flooding and tornadoes from May 22 to June 16 should apply at the Logan County office, 1015 W. Second, Oakley.

"Loans covering physical and/or production losses may be made at 3.75 percent interest," Jurey said, "and scheduled for repayment as rapidly as feasible.'

Loans covering physical losses may be used to replace installations, equipment, livestock or buildings (including homes), lost through a disaster, he said. Loans covering production losses may be used to buy feed, seed, fertilizer or livestock, or to make payments on debt.
