

Band will perform Sunday

Festhaus-Musikanten, an eight-to-10-piece wind band, will perform at 3 p.m. Sunday in the Goodland High School Auditorium.

The band, an authentic German wind orchestra, is dedicated to the performance of German folk music. Festhaus-Musikanten hopes the sounds of their authentic

polkas, waltzes and marches will transport you to the heart of Bavaria.

The orchestra's musical arrangements are imported from Germany, Austria, Switzerland, Czech Republic and Bohemia. Songs include "Rosamunde," "In Munchen steht ein Hofbrauhaus Liechtensteiner Polka Schnee-

walzer," "Radestsky March" and yes, the "Chicken Dance." It's music that lifts the soul and defines Gemutlichkeit.

Admission is by Western Plains Arts Association season ticket, or at the door, \$10 for adults and \$5 for students.

In compliance with the provisions of K.S.A. 25-2311©, notice is hereby given that the books for registration of voters of Thomas County will be open at the following places and times specified:

The County Clerk's office at 300 N. Court, Colby, during regular office hours from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

At 5:00 P.M. on March 23rd, 2009, the books will close and remain closed for the voters of Thomas County until after the City/School General Election.

A citizen of the United States who is eighteen (18) years of age and upwards, or will have attained the age of eighteen (18) years of age at the next election, must register before he or she can vote. Voter registration books close 14 days before an election.

When a voter has been registered according to law their registration shall continue to be valid until one of the following occurs:

(1)The Voter changes name by marriage, divorce or legal proceedings.
(2)The voter changes residences.
(3)The voter name has been purged according to law.

If any of the above had occurred, you must re-register.

Any person may apply in person, by telephone, or by mail to the County Election officer of Thomas County. Such application shall be signed by the applicant under penalty of perjury.
