# Foundation seeks to bring grads home

to find jobs now that we live in the computer age, she said. They can set up businesses in their own homes and even work for companies in larger towns from their own kitchen tables.

Olson said a town can encourage grads to come back by teaching entrepreneurship in our schools and communities. We should teach our children to give back to their communities and provide them with leadership skills, she said.

She said the foundation is anxious to get Colby graduates to return home and bring back their professional skills. Usually, when the young people go to the city because the wages are higher, it doesn't take them long to realize the cost of living is also much higher than in a small town. It's still cheaper to live in a small town, Olson said, and as far as recreation, people can set up their own, what ever they chose.

So far, though, there's no fund designed to lure area graduates back home.

Olson said people often ask, “How does the Thomas County Community Foundation work?” Actually it's simple, Olson said. Donors set up endowments by giving the foundation money, and the foundation invests the money to make more money.

“We use what we make to give

grants and scholarships for the betterment of the community,” she said.

Members of one women's club in Colby decided they would like to set up an endowment, and when they meet to work on their craft projects, they each write a check for their endowment. Now that money is helping the St. Francis Community Services Organization in Colby to help needy children in this area.

One way for families to honor their loved ones is to set up memorial donations through the foundation, she said. Such a memorial was set up by Erma Tubbs and her family in the honor of the late George Tubbs. The first grant from this memorial was given to the High Plains Shrine Club, in George's memory, as he was an active member of the group. The second grant was issued to the Prairie Senior Living Complex-Alzheimer's Ward.

Also, Olson said, Kimberly Gerstner recently received a \$150 grant from the William “Bill” Draper Memorial 4-H Scholarship to be a delegate at the International 4-H Youth Exchange IFYE in Japan this summer. In the past year, Melissa Baird and Rachel Juenemann got scholarships from this fund to attend the 4-H Kansas Youth Leadership Forum. It is simply people helping people, Olson said.
