When a storm strikes, you often have only a few minutes to seek shelter. It is essential for you and your family to be prepared. Safe Kids Kansas recommends becoming familiar with the type of weather you may encounter, preparing an emergency disaster kit and practicing your emergency plan frequently with the entire

Many people do not understand the difference between a weather watch and a warning. When conditions are favorable for severe weather to develop, a severe thunderstorm or tornado watch is issued. That means to be on the alert because conditions are right for severe storms, either tornadoes or thunderstorms with hail, high winds and heavy rain.

Forecasters monitor weather radar, reports from spotters and other sources to issue severe-thunderstorm and tornado warnings for areas where a storm either has been spotted or indicated by raweather alert radios. These warnings are also relayed to emergency safe and close. management and public safety of-

family member as your contact in case weather strikes while you are apart. Each family member should know the phone number, and call to alert others they are safe and where they are going to be.

Practice the plan often with your children, just as you do for other emergencies such as a house fire.

If a tornado warning is issued, your family should go to your designated shelter, which may be a storm shelter or a basement. If you are not able to get underground, then move to an interior room, hallway, bathroom or closet on the lowest level. If possible, get under a sturdy piece of furniture to protect you from debris, and stay away from windows.

If you are in a vehicle or mobile home, get out immediately and head to the nearest shelter. Do not try and outrun a tornado. If you are outside, lie flat in a low location, and cover your head with your hands. Do not take shelter under an overpass or bridge. Flash flooding causes more deaths each year than wind, so be aware of your surroundings.

After a storm has passed, watch for fallen power lines and structures damaged by the storm. Use a flashlight to inspect your home. Do not use candles, matches or lighters, as there may be leaking natural gas pipes or fuel tanks
