### National Weather Service

**Tonight:** A 30 percent chance of rain and thunderstorms, mainly after 1 a.m. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 39. Breezy, with a south wind around 20 mph, with gusts as high as 30 mph.

**Saturday:** A chance of rain before 10 a.m., then rain and snow. Some thunder is also possible. Temperature falling to around 36 by 5 p.m. Breezy, with an east wind 15 to 25 mph becoming west. Winds could gust as high as 35 mph. Chance of precipitation is 80 percent. Little or no snow accumulation expected.
