Sheriff goes without new cars

two new cars. It's highly unlikely that there will be room next year for three new vehicles.'

Commissioner Byron Sowers asked if buying three new ones a year would be something that would go on forever.

The problem with the budget now, the undersheriff said, is that drug forfeiture money was plugged in where it should not have been. Now that the criteria for its use has changed, he said, the security of those funds cannot be counted on.

"It has been more of a detriment to Thomas County than a help,' Sheriff Taylor said.

Commissioners said they used to be able to count on a little help from interest, but because of the economy, the budget will be short about \$130,000 this year.

"We will be lucky to get \$20,000 (in interest) this year," Steele said, "compared to 2007, when we got \$220,000."

Commissioners told the sheriff to come back in October or November to see what the county has in accumulated sales tax money.

County Attorney Bruce Flipse presented a rough copy of an agreement to work out rights of way and roads for the proposed wind farm in Lacey, Morgan, North Randall and Summers townships.
