Heart association promotes cardiac emergency training

With an eye towards saving more heart-attack victims, this week is National Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation / Automated External Defibrillator Awareness Week.

The American Heart Association wants to see a million Americans commit to getting trained in resuscitation and how to use an automated external defibrillator.

Sudden cardiac arrest can happen anywhere, the association says. Every year, emergency medical services treats about 300,000 victims of out-of-hospital cardiac arrest. More than 92 percent of people struck outside the hospital will die. Without immediate resuscitation, the chance of surviving drops 7 to 10 percent for each minute that passes. Unfortunately, less than one third of out-of-hospital cardiac arrest victims receive resuscitation from a bystander.

More training is needed, the association says. Seventy percent of bystanders who respond to a cardiac emergency have either never received training or their training was more than five years ago, the group says. To keep skills current, training should occur at least every two years.

There are two ways to become trained in cardiopulmonary re-

suscitation: take a traditional classroom-based course, or get a self-paced Anytime Kit, which includes an inflatable manikin and instructional video disk.

"By learning CPR, you are taking care of yourself and your family with just a small time commitment. The more you practice, the

more confident your skills will be in a real emergency," said Dr. Michael Sayre, chair-elect of the association's Emergency Cardiovascular Care Committee.
