# Extension district starts to northeast

Decatur and Norton counties will join in the new Twin Creeks Extension District starting July 1. The counties will share two full-time agents splitting similar responsibilities, and the district will have a family and consumer sciences specialist 40 percent of the week, said area director Dr. Chris Onstad.

Extension offices will continue to serve clients in both counties, he said. The Decatur County office is in the courthouse at 120 E. Hall St. in Oberlin, and the Norton County office is at 100 S. Norton St. in Norton.

The agriculture and natural resources agents are Keith Van Skike in Norton and Byron Hale in Oberlin. Family and consumer sciences specialist Tranda Watts, who currently covers a five-county area including Norton and Decatur counties, will continue to deliver programming in those counties.

The district was approved several months ago by the Kansas attorney general's office. It will be the ninth multicounty district formed under K-State Research and Extension. Sherman and Wallace counties form the Sunflower Extension District.
