Perry "Redhead" Murray

March 23, 1947 - June 15, 2009

Perry was born in Colby, Kansas to Charles Dwight and Maurine Murray. Perry attended Colby Elementary School. Perry followed in his fathers footsteps by enrolling at Wentworth Military Academy in Lexington Missouri. After graduation, Perry went to Washburn University and Washburn Law School. Perry was a member of the Alpha Delta Fraternity. After law school, Perry worked for the state of Kansas in the Fuel Allocation division for almost two years.

Perry returned to Colby, Kansas in 1974 to start his law practice and farm with his father. Perry was appointed to the position of Thomas County Attorney and then ran and won election to that position. Perry was the Thomas County Attorney from 1979 to 1988. The two cases that he will be most remembered for are the Colby Hospital Board and the Remeta trial.

Perry moved to Denver, Colorado in 1989 to work for the Denver City Attorney's Office. After awhile he went into private practice with his cousin. Perry and his wife, Nanette moved to Gold Canyon, Arizona in 1999 where he was able to indulge in his favorite hobby of golf. Perry was an outdoorsman who loved hunting and fishing with all of his friends.

Perry is survived by his wife, Nanette, his son Michael and Lindsey Murray of Bailey, Colorado, his granddaughters Izabel Maurine of Bailey, Colorado and Brooke Leigh of Colby, Kansas, his son Chris Murray of Colby, Kansas and his sister Deanna and Paul Adams of Tucson, Arizona.

Inurnment will be at Crown Hill Cemetery in Denver, Colorado in a private ceremony.
