**Utah man named new director to Sternberg Museum at Fort Hays**

Dr. Reese Barrick has been named the new director of the Sternberg Museum of Natural History at Fort Hays State University. Barrick comes from the College of Eastern Utah, Price, where he served as the director of the prehistoric museum for the past six years. He replaces Dr. Jerry Choate who retired last June.

Barrick holds bachelor degrees in biology and geology from Cornell College in Iowa, with master's and doctorate in geological science from the University of Southern California in Los Angeles.

In addition to working in a larger museum than he has in the past, the reputation of the museum was

what drew Barrick to Hays. It has more than three million specimens, many of which are used primarily for research purposes. Among these exhibits is the well-preserved Gillicus fish within another fish called Xyphactinus. Both were collected by George F. Sternberg in 1952.

Museum membership is available to all for a minimal fee, which allows free admissions to the museum located at 3000 Sternberg Drive in Hays as well as more than 250 other museums and science centers worldwide. For information, go to [www.fhsu.edu/sternberg](http://www.fhsu.edu/sternberg).
