Workshop will help with historic grants

The Kansas State Historic Preservation Office will award Historic Preservation Fund grants in May. A workshop for applicants will be held at 2 p.m., Thursday, Oct. 8, at the Kansas Historical Society, 6425 SW 6th Avenue, Topeka.

Registration is not required for applicants, but is requested. Call (785) 272-8681, ext. 245, for information.

The Federal Historic Preservation Fund provides help to state and tribal preservation offices each year. This money used to expand and accelerate historic preservation activities. Federal regulations require that part of the money go to communities and preservation organizations.

The Kansas office awards grants each year to organizations such as historical societies, universities, regional planning commissions, nonprofit corporations, and city and county governments to help with projects. These competitive grants are used to pay for historic property surveys, National Register nomi-

nations, preservation plans, design-review guidelines, and educational activities.

A grant must result in a completed, tangible product, and must pertain to programs outlined in the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966. The grant may be used for up to 60 percent of costs, with the rest coming from the sponsor.

Stamp shows coming in Hays

The Fort Hays Stamp Club will hold two exhibits during October.

There will be a month-long display of stamp collections beginning Thursday, Oct. 1, at the Hays Public Library Children's Department. This show will include 60 to 100 collections that feature the 50 states, birds, animals, flowers, famous figures, sports and state birds. Other commemorative stamps will include the original 13 states and Olympic stamps, with about a thousand stamps on display.

The deadline for preliminary applications is Feb. 1. Final applications must be postmarked no later than March 15, or delivered in person by 4:30 p.m. on that date. Awards will be announced May 8.
