

Fort offers candlelight tours

On Saturday, Oct. 10, a special candlelight tour through time will be held as part of the 150th anniversary of Fort Larned. Various scenes will give visitors a chance to step back in time to the establishment of the original Camp on the Pawnee Fork in 1859, then progress through time to Fort Larned becoming a National Historic Site. The history nature trail will be used as part of the tour route so some events can be shown on the actual spot that they took place.

Reservations are required and each tour group, departing every fifteen minutes, is limited to 20 people.

The first tour will leave the visitor center at 7 p.m. and the last will depart at 10:15 p.m. Reservations can be made beginning Monday, Sept. 28, in person or by calling the Fort at (620) 285-6911 between 9 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. This annual program is the most popular event held at the Fort and tours fill quickly. There is no cost for the candlelight tour.

Fort Larned National Historic Site is located six miles west of Larned on K-156. Open 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily except Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day, admission is free. Information can be found on the internet at www.nps.gov/fols.

Cosmosphere open free on Saturday

The Kansas Cosmosphere and Space Center is participating in the fifth annual Smithsonian Museum Day on Saturday. Visitors with a Smithsonian pass will be admitted free to the museum that day. The Cosmosphere is the only Smithsonian-affiliated museum in Kansas.

A celebration of culture, learning and the dissemination of knowledge, Museum Day emulates the free-admission policy of the Smithsonian Institution's Washington, DC-based properties. Doors will be open free of charge to Smithsonian Magazine readers and smithsonian.com visitors at

museums and cultural institutions nationwide.

Cosmosphere President and CEO, Chris Orwoll, says, "The Cosmosphere has been proud to work closely with the Smithsonian Institution and its National Air and Space Museum for over two decades now."

Last year, about 200,000 people attended Museum Day, in over 900 participating museums nationwide, including 84 Smithsonian affiliates. Twenty-five museums in Kansas are participating.

Meeting to teach about heart

Dr. Gary Benton, Chief Surgeon of Cardiothoracic and Vascular Surgery at the DeBakey Heart Institute at Hays Medical Center will present a free town hall meeting at 6 p.m. on Thursday, Oct. 8 at the Sternberg Museum in Hays.

Benton will discuss atrial fibrillation, or irregular heart rhythms, a heart disorder that affects more than 2.2 million Americans and is one of the most frequent causes of stroke. With this disorder, the upper chambers of the heart develop a different rhythm from

the lower chambers and cause the heart to beat irregularly. This can cause the upper chambers to become paralyzed and form blood clots, which can eventually cause a stroke. People who suffer from this disorder can experience fatigue, shortness of breath and in extreme incidences, loss of blood pressure which can be life threatening.




