Educators, community leaders and citizens will be looking at ways to strengthen the economy and enhance the quality of life for area communities when Northwest Kansas Technical College in Goodland holds their Rural School and Community Development Conference on Friday, Oct 30.

Dr. Paul Theobald, Woods-Beal Endowed Chair in Urban and Rural Education at Buffalo State College will be the featured speaker. He is a scholar and expert on the history of education, as well as the author of several books. Theobald's work in rural schooling and communities is known through his publications.

Kansas Lt. Gov. Troy Findley will speak on growing the Kansas economy, creating jobs and protecting families and communities.
