Pesticide applicator training in November

Kansas State University Research and Extension will hold commercial pesticide applicator recertification training this year in Hays on Monday and Tuesday, Nov. 9 and 10.

"These training sessions are for ... individuals who have become licensed to apply pesticides to someone else's property for compensation," said Frannie Miller, coordinator of K-State's Pesticide Safety and Integrated Pest Management Program. "This applies to farmers who spray for their neighbors, residential pesticide applicators, the personnel who control noxious weeds, and many others."

To renew certification in Kansas, individuals can either study a manual and pass an examination or attend training approved by the state secretary of agriculture.

The training provides practical updates as well as helping commercial pesticide applicators meet state requirements, Miller said.

The Hays session will be at the Fort Hays State University Memorial Union, with registration at 11:30 a.m. and the program at noon.

Universities offer workshop on agriculture insurance issues

Kansas State University Research and Extension is teaming up with the University of Nebraska, Oklahoma State University and Colorado State University to offer workshops on insurance issues in agriculture.

The Kansas workshop will be Thursday, Nov. 12, at the Salina Ramada Inn, 1616 W. Crawford.

Speakers will include agricultural economists from the Extension services of each state university, as well as commercial banking representatives and officials with the Federal Reserve Bank.

Presentations will cover: the

economic situation, managing risk with the new farm income safety net, how the Supplemental Revenue Assistance Program will change crop insurance decisions, grain and oilseed outlook, actuarial and underwriting changes for 2010, and the risks and rewards of agricultural contracting.

Cost to attend is \$85 at least five days in advance or \$100 at the door.
