school districts that make up the Schools for Fair Funding coalition are considering whether to sue the state for more education money as frustration grows over spending cuts.

John Robb, lead attorney for the group, which has been fighting in court since 1999 for increases in school spending, said the districts fear budget cuts will harm students and see another lawsuit as the "lesser of two evils," The Wichita Eagle reported Sunday.

Lawmakers insist Kansans can't afford another court battle, however.
