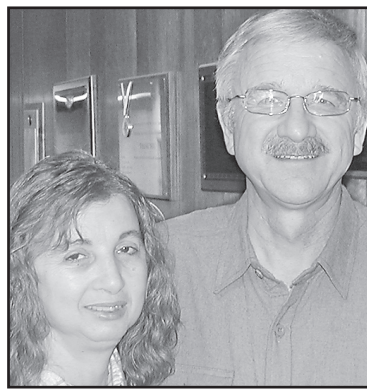

The couple came to the church as part of Village Missions, a missionary service that provides pas-

Kathie said she also enjoys music as well as reading, embroidery and putting together photo albums. The couple has three children. A daughter, Gwen, and her family are involved in a Christian camp-

ing ministry in Laramie, Wyo. Another daughter, Jana, is a case manager who helps emotionally disabled kids and is engaged to a minister in Hillsboro. A son, Josh, is serving with the Air Force at Offutt Air Force Base in Omaha. The church holds Sunday school at 9:30 a.m. and worship at 10:45 a.m. each week.
