Signup for the Supplemental some federal payments. Revenue Assistance Payments program under the 2008 Farm bill starts today for losses in the 2008 crop year.

Adrian J. Polansky, state executive director of the U.S. Farm Service Agency, said the supplemental program provides crop disaster assistance to farmers with production or quality losses, providing up to 60 percent of the difference between the federal guarantee and total farm revenue.

A farm's guarantee is based on the amount of crop insurance and Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program coverage. Total farm revenue takes into account the actual value of production as well as insurance payments and Disaster Assistance Programs.

To be eligible, farmers must have suffered at least a 10 percent pro-

duction loss on a crop. They must have signed up for crop insurance or noninsured disaster assistance coverage for all major crops. The farm must be in a county covered by a federal disaster declaration or

suffer a 50 percent production loss due to a natural disaster. "This program is an important component of the farm safety net and will provide financial assistance to producers who have suffered crop losses due to natural
