Burlington no-till meet in February

The High Plains No-Till Conference will be offered Tuesday and Wednesday, Feb. 2 and 3, at the Burlington, Colo., Community Center, 340 S. 14th St.
 It will feature a trade show with more than 50 vendors, educational breakout sessions and keynote speaker Murray Wise. Wise is the founder of the Westchester Group, which has been in business 23 years and manages over \$770 million in agricultural assets.
 Wise will speak on what drives the world agriculture economy. His No. 1 focus will be China. He will give a look at savings rates as well a grain stocks and grain and oil-seed usage.
 Wise says that growth in Chinese milk production and use since 2000 is a story within itself. His presentation, "Global Agriculture, 2010 and Beyond," will include information on U.S. land prices, cash rental rates and water consumption and utilization.
 In Wise's view, global agriculture, particularly U.S. agriculture, has an extremely bright outlook and he says he looks forward to sharing it at the conference.
 Many of the sessions will offer continuing educational units for certified crop advisors in Colorado and credits for commercial and private applicators in both Colorado and Kansas.
 Registration fees before Jan. 26 are \$100 for farmers and ranchers, \$70 for spouses, and \$25 a day for students and FFA members. Sessions being at 8 a.m. both days.
