





SALMON CROQUETTES



The Saga of Endplay Charlie


Nobody ever contended that Endplay Charlie was a great player. His bidding was bad, his defense mediocre, and his dummy play – in general 2. left much to be desired.

But when it came to endplays, nobody could surpass Charlie. He could smell an endplay a mile away, and he was never happier than when 23 he was executing one. His talent was really exceptional, and if the rest of his game had only 26 been on a par with it, he would have ranked as the best player in the world. Here is an example of Charlie strutting his

stuff. Perhaps West shouldn't have doubled six spades – particularly with Endplay Charlie at the 3 helm – but West felt sure he had two trump tricks, so he did.

Charlie thereupon proceeded to wrap the contract around West's neck. Warned by the double that West had all the missing trumps, Charlie held him to one trump trick.

He started by discarding a heart on the king of clubs and ruffed a club. After cashing the A-K of diamonds and ruffing a diamond, he trumped another club. Next he played the A-K of hearts and ruffed a heart, producing this position:
North



Charlie now led the ace of clubs, ruffed it with the eight, and then played the jack of diamonds. If did not matter which card West ruffed with – he could score only one trump trick!
