Wilbur F. Henry, 70, died Monday, Feb. 8, 2010, at his home in Colby. He was born Feb. 23, 1939, in Colby.

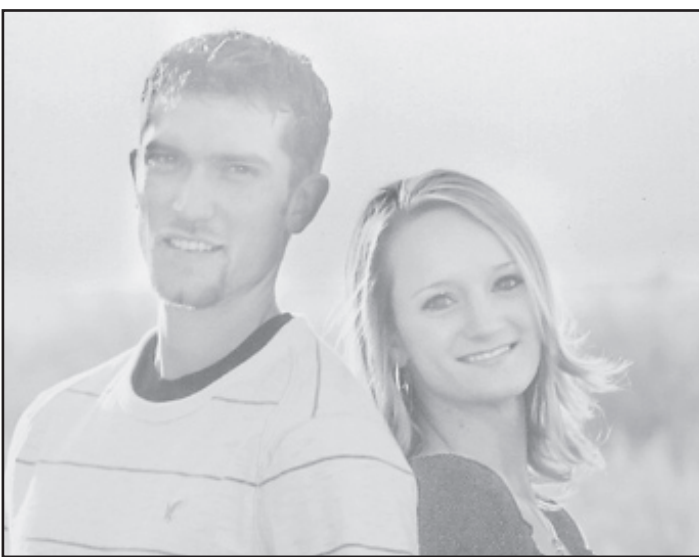
