Troopers lock deputy in dog cage after arrest

BLOUNTVILLE, Tenn. (AP) — A Tennessee sheriff's deputy arrested on a drunk driving charge wound up in a dog house before he was taken to the big house.

The *Kingsport Times-News* reported the details of a Tennessee Highway Patrol arrest report, which said 47-year-old Samuel Monroe Bledsoe was kicking the windows of a trooper's cruiser on his way to a hospital for a blood test.

The report says Bledsoe was

then locked inside the cruiser's K-9 cage for his own safety.

Trooper David Osborne said in the report that Bledsoe performed poorly during a field sobriety test — even after it was explained to the deputy 18 times.

The Sullivan County Sheriff's Office later fired Bledsoe.

The former officer was free Wednesday on \$1,500 bond. A message left at a phone number listed for Bledsoe was not immediately returned.
