## Helicopter rescues horse

BUCKEYE, Ariz. (AP) — It's not every day you see a horse fly.

A helicopter flew the horse, Colorado, to safety after he spent five days stranded on a sand bar in the Gila River about 36 miles southwest of Phoenix.

The river's swift-moving current prevented an earlier rescue and the horse was trapped on the bar with a few bushes and trees to munch on. His rider was one of three people rescued after they

tried to ride through the river in March.

The horse was prepped for the flight, getting a tranquilizer before being placed in a harness with blinders on.

Once he was airborne, Colorado flew effortlessly and never bucked. A crowd awaited his arrival on the river bank after he flew about a half mile.

Anonymous donors paid for the rescue.

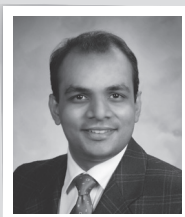
