The Rev. Ralph L. Aschenbrenner, 74, died Tuesday, April 27, 2010, at the Harry Hines Hospice at Via Christ-St. Francis Hospital in Wichita.

Father Aschenbrenner was born Oct. 1, 1935, in Colby, the son of Philip and Rose (Schuster) Aschenbrenner. He attended Kenrick Seminary in St. Louis and was ordained a priest at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Colby by Bishop Frederick Freking on March 18, 1961.

Father Aschenbrenner served parishes in the Diocese of Salina, and was judge and procurator/advocate on the diocesan tribunal from 1972 until he retired in 2007. He has since lived at the Catholic Life Center in Wichita.

He was preceded in death by his parents; three sisters, Regina, Anna, and Rose; and three brothers,
