Grants for rural housing repairs available

The U.S. Department of Agriculture Rural Development agency is accepting applications for grants to help low- and very-low-income rural residents repair their homes. The Rural Development Housing Preservation Grant Program provides financial assistance to sponsoring organizations to assist in the repair and/or rehabilitation of single-family and rental residences located in rural communities. State Director Patty commented, "The availability of affordable housing in our rural areas

continues to be a major factor which contributes to economic development."

Grants can be used to weatherize and repair existing structures, install or improve plumbing or provide access to people with disabilities.

Eligible sponsors to administer the grant funds can include state agencies, local government and nonprofit organizations. The program can also help rental property owners to repair and/or rehabilitate units providing they are

made available to very-low and low-income families. The program provides assistance in communities with a maximum population of 20,000.

The grants are part of Rural Development's annual budget.
