This allowed the squads to have point totals that were larger than their regional scores. For example, a person who finished 12th in the 800-meter dash at regionals could have ended up having the fifthfastest time for the division.

To qualify for nationals in the decathlon, you must have one of the top 16 scores in the United States. This differs from other events, where you have to get at or below a certain time at any point in the season to qualify. Elliot's score at regionals was 12th in the nation, coach James Ortiz said. He should officially qualify this weekend.
