Last year's event was deemed a success when 137 kids registered and brought along many parents and grandparents.

"We're pleased that the grant has been reinstated," Kaaz said, "and this year we'll stock twice the number of fish as we did last year."

"The college purchased about 125 fish in 2009, but will purchase and release twice the numbers into the lake for this year's event. Average weight last year was around 2 pounds," he added.

Kaaz noted that the fish will be released into the lake a couple of days ahead, to give them a chance to get stabilized and hungry before the derby, but it is his hope that the area can be barricaded to keep early-bird fishermen from fishing the lake before kids

get a chance to throw their lines into the water.

District fisheries biologist Dave Salsbury of the Kansas State Wildlife and Parks will give a short presentation before lines go into the water Saturday morning.

A food stand will be available by the college cheerleaders, plus a face painting booth.

Kaaz expressed appreciation to the Schwankes for offering extra parking at Colby Bowl, The Bank for their donation, C&M Gun Shop for fishing pole prizes, Hi-Plains Co-op for their donation and for purchasing the bait, Woofter Construction and Irrigation for the tagged fish, and to the Kansas State Wildlife and Parks for the grant.

Kaaz added he is hoping for another nice day like the one they had last year.

Foundation announces scholarships

The Pete Henry Scholarships were created through the estate of Pierre "Pete" Henry, who farmed for many years in the Brewster area.

Friends said Henry had an inquiring mind and knew the value of hard work, thrift and good management. He was born in 1910 and raised on a farm near Campbell, Neb.

Pete left Nebraska when he was 21 for California. Times were hard. He slept in cars, washed dishes for food and eventually rented a garage for \$6 a month to sleep in.

He signed on with the Civilian Conservation Corps to harvest trees and build roads, working for the Forest Service. A forester recognized his engineering talent and assigned Henry to the library, where he immersed himself in a surveying course.

Later in the 1930s, Henry was hired by Douglas Aircraft Co. to work in the engineering department, designing and building fighter planes, all with only an eighth-grade education.

The 1940s found Henry in and out of the Army Air Corp, where he was a flight engineer on B-17, B-24 and B-29 aircraft. He participated in top-secret training with some of the airmen who dropped the atomic bomb.

In 1949, Henry rented ground south of Brewster from former neighbors in Nebraska. He adapted his Nebraska farming experiences to western Kansas.

He mostly worked alone on the farm until he was 88, and until his

death in 2002 made all the management decisions.

His dream was to help area students get an education. He established a foundation to award academic and technical scholarships.

type a brief description of the problem and its location.

"The more detailed the description, the easier it is for us to find," Wederski said.

Once a form has been submitted, a person can come back any time to view it. They can make changes, post a better description or even upload a photo. Wederski

said the city can also post updates to tell citizens where they are at on the problem, whether they are waiting, out fixing it or finished.

Wederski said he has written a small tutorial for the feature, which is available on the site's main page, and anyone who has trouble with the form or the site should contact Widerski at techassist@cityofcolby.com.
