Stopping thief costs her job

WICHITA (AP) - An employee of a Wal-Mart store in Wichita was fired after she stopped a man from stealing a \$600 computer. Heather Ravenstein, a 30-year-old single mother of a 4-year-old, says she was fired after she followed a man out of the store last Friday and demanded proof that he bought the computer. The *Wichita Eagle* reports that the man kicked and hit Ravenstein

before letting go of the computer and fleeing. Ravenstein was not seriously injured. But she says an assistant manager fired her the next day, citing company policy that only a manager or security person should stop a customer from stealing. A Wal-Mart spokeswoman says the company appreciates Ravenstein's intentions, but she put herself and others in danger.
